Testing season is here. Beginning May 1, students will have state mandated testing over the next 3 weeks. This week, starting on Wednesday, students will take the FAST ELA Progress Monitoring 3 test. Please make sure students are well rested, on time, and bring a charged Chromebook with them for testing days. Please see the Deadlines and Impt Dates section for a list of all upcoming tests. Parents we will send a reminder letter out via Talking Points one week prior to each test. All high school FAST and End of Course Tests are computer based adaptive tests. Please click here to learn more about the how the tests are adaptive and how that impacts how the students take the test – this is new this year. Here is also a short video to explain how the algorithm charts the course for your student's test questions based on responses. Please discuss the importance of these tests with your students. The results are used for placement in classes next year, including support classes to improve reading and math proficiency for students who do not demonstrate mastery. Not giving best effort could result in students losing elective periods and support classes being added into their schedule for next year. Scores, beginning with ELA, will be posted in the Family Portal beginning at 2:00 PM on May 8th. Here is a guide on how to access the portal to see scores.
