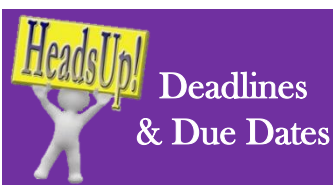

- **Report Cards go home with students Tues 1/16**
- **Celebrate Literacy Week 1/22 – 1/26**



We were excited to welcome the Class of 2027 back for semester 2 last week. Now how fast did that first semester go?? On Tuesday, report cards will be sent home with students. While grades are important, please pay close attention to the bottom right hand portion of the report card. Here you will find critical GPA and credit information for your student. To be on track for promotion (and graduation in a short 3.5 more years), your student should have at least a 2.0 Cumulative GPA and no less than 2 credits at this time. 96% of our students have earned two or more credits, while 75% have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. If your student failed the first semester of a core class (Math, ELA, Science, World History) Mr. Clark will be meeting with them to go ahead and place them into a credit recovery course that they can be working on during this semester. This will allow them to recover that credit and improve their GPA. Please keep in mind we have tutorial after school on Tuesday and Thursday each week and that would be a great time for your student to work on credit recovery – quiet environment, access to Wi-Fi, teacher support. We will also offer some students who have less than a 2.0 the opportunity to work on credit retrieval to raise GPA. Please keep in mind that semester 1 is done and now is the time to keep on track for semester 2. Please check Skyward often and support our teachers' efforts by not allowing your student to earn zeros due to not completing assignments. That single expectation makes a huge difference in student learning, grades, and credit completion!

Schedule changes are open for 2nd semester. Students have access to a Google form to sign up to see Mr. Clark. After Jan 22, the form will close. Please note that while we look at each request, our ability to honor them takes many factors into account, including keeping teacher classes balanced and below the required class size limits.

Congratulations to our students who will be competing in the district science fair this week. Awards will be on Wednesday, Jan 17th at Osceola Middle School at 7 pm. Doors will open at 6:30 for the parents and public to view the projects.

Spring sports tryouts will be happening in January, starting with girl's lacrosse in a couple of weeks. Be sure physicals are done and Final Forms are completed. Packets with sports info are available in the main office (205).

The Winter Wonderland dance scheduled for Jan 26th has been cancelled. We are in the planning stages of a February Formal for our students – tentative date is Feb 17th. More information will be in the next newsletter.

IRSC will be offering a section of Student Learning Success (SLS 1101) starting on January 25th and running through April 25th. The class will meet in person on Thursday nights, 5:30 – 6:45 pm. Students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, Reading PERT scores of 106, and an IRSC Dual Enrollment Application on file. If your student plans to take Dual Enrollment in high school, this is the first course they take and is required before additional coursework.
