If your student is absent from school, please remember to submit a parent excuse note. District attendance policy allows us to accept up to 9 excused days for each semester with a parent excuse note. More than 15 unexcused absences in a semester may result in your student's driver's license being suspended. Please submit all excuse notes to our attendance secretary, Mrs. Shuey. Students can take the notes to her in 206 or turn them in to their 3rd period teacher to be turned in.

Students recently completed their FAST ELA Progress Montoring 1 test. Parents can access these results via the Florida Family Portal.
