And just like that we are halfway through the first quarter of school year 2020 – 2021. The past 3 weeks have flown by as students have learned not only academics but some key elements of being a Brahman, including the first few lessons about the aspects of PRIDE. Lessons will continue over the next few weeks and faculty reward students with Brahman Bucks when they display these characteristics on campus. Two key academic areas of focus at OHSFC are the use of AVID Strategies campus wide and the introduction of Pre-AP English Language Arts and Pre-AP Algebra 1. AVID strategies support student learning in a variety of ways, including helping to improve students' ability to retain information. Watch this short video about Rate of Forgetting to understand why teachers ask students to revisit their notes. Support our teachers by asking students to do this often at home using the 10/24/7 strategy in the video. Students are well under way in their Pre-AP classes, including completing the process for setting up their College Board accounts in their ELA classes. These accounts will be important for students to access content for classes this year but will also be useful for Khan Academy practice for SAT in years to come and any future Advanced Placement courses students take. Pre-AP classes are on-grade-level courses that help build, strengthen, and reinforce students' content knowledge and critical thinking skills. It is our belief that every student should be prepared for college-level work and the skills and knowledge from Pre-AP classes are the first steps in ensuring students have those skills for high school and beyond.
