This week is the first JV and Varsity Football home games. It will also be Senior Night for Football and Cheer. Tickets are limited! Only 600 tickets are reserved for the home side (25% capacity) and 200 for away. JV tickets will be sold at the home gatehouse until capacity is reached. Varsity Football and Cheer parents have 4 tickets reserved (\$6 each). Parent Cards (specific to the athlete) for football and cheer will be distributed at practice. These cards will guarantee you access to purchase 4 tickets (max.) at the home gate house. You must have this parent card to purchase your four tickets. Parent-reserved-tickets that are not purchased by 7:15 PM will be sold to the general public. All tickets will be \$6 (no student tickets and no passes) and sold at the gate until we have reached capacity (no e-tickets this game). Parking will be \$5 per vehicle. Please note that there are special rules and procedures that must be observed while on campus: All spectators must wear a mask while on campus. (Face shields are not permitted in place of the mask.) All spectators will have their temperature checked on the forehead, prior to the purchase of the ticket. Please socially distance yourselves in the stands. No spectators will be given access to the game field before, during, or even after the game. All spectators must remain in the stadium seats (no one will be permitted to stand in the rocks, at the fence, or play in the grass). Concession stand will be limited to pre-packaged items only. OHSFC students attending either game will need their ID to be allowed to purchase tickets unless with an adult.
