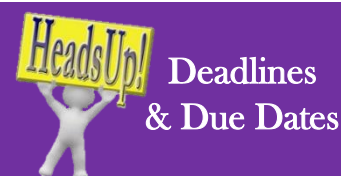

The Okeechobee County School District will host a Town Hall Meeting on Tuesday, April 26, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. in the School Board Office, Room 303, 700 S.W. Second Avenue, Okeechobee. The Superintendent will share draft plans for the Replacement of Okeechobee High School and a presentation on Career and Technical Education Offerings.
